

NAVIGATING OUR HARRIS/TRABUE ANCESTORS

Each ancestor is assigned a number: even numbers for males and odd numbers for females. The numbers represent an ancestor's parental place or generation on the Ancestor Pedigree Chart.

For instance, the Ancestor Pedigree Chart begins with the ten Harris/Trabue children as a group. Every child in this group is assigned the number (1) one.

Charles Robert Harris, the father of Group 1, is assigned number (2) two and Hortense Trabue, the mother, is assigned number (3) three and indicates their parental place on the pedigree chart.

Grandparent ancestors are numbered (4) to (7) and great-grandparent ancestors are numbered (8) to (15). Multiple times great-grandparents are indicated with a number after great-, such as: "great²" for two times great and "great³" for three times great.

Use the Ancestor Pedigree Chart as a reference to keep track of our ancestors as you read *the Harris/Trabue Family Genealogy & History: The Story of Us* and to determine the parental generation for each provided Ancestor Profile page. When information about an ancestor remains undiscovered, the pedigree chart will designate "Unknown." The Profile page for that unknown ancestor is not included.

Following each Ancestor Profile page, photos of the vital records sources such as the census, marriage, and death records found on online genealogy websites (from which data was taken to identify ancestors and extended family members) are included. This allows you to see the actual documents created by our ancestors when they lived. Also, the names of our parental ancestors are highlighted in yellow on the records.

Regarding our ancestors' records, please note that reassignment of ancestors' race, errors in the spelling of ancestors' names, ages, dates, and places are evident. These kinds of information depended on what individuals believed was accurate about themselves or about their family member when asked questions for the censuses, or at the time of birth, marriage, and death. In fact, the census takers designated race by assumption and often phonetically spelled the names. Also, modern transcribers of handwritten records often misinterpreted archaic handwriting or simply made typing errors. All records here are presented unedited and as they were found.

THE STORY OF US

Who am I? Why am I interested in this subject and not another? Why was I attracted to my profession? Where does my "never give up" attitude come from? Where did my surname come from?

Genealogy can be a blueprint to many questions we have about ourselves. Learning what interested our ancestors and how they struggled and created a meaningful life for themselves and their families is a direct route to understanding and appreciating who we are.

THE TRABUE LINEAGE

LeRoy Trabue married Edna Beatrice Manning three days before Christmas in 1915, when our country was on the verge of entering World War I. Our country's draft call sounded in 1917; and at the age of 27, LeRoy fulfilled his duty to register. Beatrice was already two months pregnant with their first child, Gwendolyn, due seven months

later in January 1918.

Called the Great Americans were leaving the factory employment metropolises of the North. Government stopped before we entered the war, workers to fill unskilled recruited southern Black willing to work for lower pay affiliation.

The summer of 1919 earned its title "Red Summer" named by the NAACP's activist leader James Weldon Johnson, when race riots erupted in towns across the country. Whites resented Black workers who filled labor jobs previously held by unionized White workers. Angry White mobs attacked Blacks in their neighborhoods around the country.

Chicago was recovering from its own deadly riots when LeRoy and Beatrice gave birth to their second daughter (3) Hortense in December of 1919. The Trabues were fortunate to be located in an immigrant neighborhood, though their White neighbors had begun to flee it.

Hortense and Gwendolyn were born into a bustling White immigrant community in Chicago. Their apartment building at 222 East 46th Street housed four families of which one was White. The Trabues were one of the five Black families out of a total of thirteen families on the entire block. Those families were Germans, Pols, Italians, Swedes, and Greeks whose fathers and mothers were naturalized American citizens in the 1880s and 1890s. Everyone could read and write English. Some of the occupations of their neighbors were servant, office manager, salesman, electrical engineer, grocery importer, music teacher, nurse, and physician. LeRoy Trabue (6) was the pharmacist on the block. Although LeRoy didn't serve in the military, a pharmacist was a valued and essential member of the community; and Black pharmacists were rare.

The 1920s ended with the economic crash of the stock market in 1929 which had ushered in the Great Depression of the 1930s. The Trabues had to tighten their belts after employers were forced to cut jobs to essential workers if they could remain in business at all. The first to be let go were the Black workers. Unemployment was the rule of the day. LeRoy, to his credit

Having survived the global Influenza Epidemic of 1918 with their family intact, LeRoy and Beatrice added their first son to the family in 1922, named after his father. To their sorrow in 1925, three months before his third birthday, LeRoy Jr. died. Emotions were soon uplifted by the births of three more sons: Gerald in 1927, Clarence in 1932, and Harry in 1936; a total of five living children.

and work ethic, managed to stay employed in the pharmacy industry, but as a stockman in a drug store.

LeRoy and Beatrice moved their children a few blocks south to 328 E. 56th Street where rent was less expensive, the place where son Clarence was born, and later to 5631 Prairie Avenue. In this Chicago Black Belt neighborhood, their one apartment

building housed eleven families. Most residents on the block were from Georgia, but every southern state was represented. All adults could read and write.

Their daughters soon entered Englewood High School, still integrated by White students with an all-White faculty. Hortense was well-liked by her classmates and active in school group activities. She excelled in her classes and received her

certificate for completing

the Four Year Pharmacy Course. In her high school year book, the graduates were asked, "What do you want to accomplish?" Hortense answered, "To see the wind howling as well as hear it." She also aspired to become a pharmacist like her father. Hortense graduated in 1938.

About 1940, LeRoy had

regained his position as a pharmacist and a yearly salary of \$1,440, equivalent to about \$25,000 today. The Trabues mortgaged a single family home at 1801 Hartrey in a segregated Black neighborhood in the City of Evanston across Chicago's

northern border. This move continued the tradition of homeownership that he knew when


he left his parental home in Indiana.

Meanwhile, daughter (3) Hortense Phyllis Trabue met a strong-willed, hardworking young man named (2) Charles Robert Harris of Evanston. He was the man she needed to help her forge a successful family life in the discriminatory society of that era. When they married in October 1940, he at age 24 and she at age 20, they began

married life in the home of her in-laws at 1914 Asbury. They lived next door to what had been the Evanston Sanitarium and Training School (later named Butler Memorial Hospital) founded in 1914 by Black husband and wife physicians on the third floor of their home at 1918 Asbury until 1930 when it merged with new Community Hospital. Prior to the merger, it was the first and only medical care facility

to serve the 5,000 population of African Americans north of Chicago.

Once again America prepared for war in 1942 and LeRoy fulfilled his duty to register for the WW II Draft. He was age 51. By 1947, at age 57, LeRoy was retired from Pharmacy and employed as a chauffeur for a North Shore banker, according to family oral history.

Our Roots Grow Deeper: Andrew Jackson Trabue:



LeRoy's father, (12) Andrew Jackson Trabue was born in 1855 in Kentucky, six years before the Civil War began. Kentucky was a slave state, but elected to remain with the Union.

When Jackson, as he was known, left his home in Louisville, Kentucky, he left behind many extended family members. Many Trabues there were tradesmen in carpentry and building. His parents, (24) C. Trabue and (25), Margaret Trabue, noted on record, were also born in Kentucky. The years of their births were estimated to range between 1805 and 1815, but a confident connection to



Jackson remains unmade. Jackson arrived in Indianapolis about 1885 at age 30.

Soon, Jackson met and married (13) Susan Ann Pope in 1887. They were ages of 32 and 33. He became the stepfather to Susie Ann's two children and they held a

mortgage on the farm he worked on in Marion County. By 1900, he was the father of their sons LeRoy Trabue and his three brothers Oliver, Otto, and Russell.

In 1907 after 20 years of marriage, Hortense Trabue's paternal grandmother (13) Susie Ann Pope Trabue passed at age 53. By 1910, Oliver was absent from the record as well and it is assumed that he died.

About 1908, LeRoy graduated, likely from Shortridge High School, the only public high school in Indianapolis. His father Jackson remained selfemployed, but was a cement contractor in 1910. He now owned his farm home free of a mortgage.

In 1911, at age 21, LeRoy first married Mary Lewis (not the sister of ancestor (27) Elizabeth Lewis). Her absence from later records may mean

she died, although the year of her passing hasn't yet come to light. There were no apparent children from this union.

After graduating, LeRoy began his apprenticeship in pharmacy. At this time, no college education was required, but the years of pharmacy training under the tutelage of a master pharmacist were exacting and thorough. In the early decades of the twentieth

century, many medications were compounded from separate ingredients by hand to the physician's written prescription or elixirs prepared upon the pharmacist's knowledge. Therefore a pharmacist's experience, skill, and integrity were essential to properly dispensing medications.

When LeRoy reached proficiency as a pharmacist, he wasn't allowed to sign his name to the prescriptions he prepared because he was a Black man. These

discriminatory attitudes prevented him from practicing the full scope of his profession.

So, LeRoy, a young widower, left Indianapolis about 1913 and went to Chicago. In Illinois LeRoy practiced pharmacy, the profession for which he was trained. Sons Otto and Russell remained at home through the 1920s working as farm laborers supporting their father, perhaps unable to work due to

poor health. On February 18, 1930 Hortense's paternal grandfather (12) Andrew Jackson Trabue passed at the age of 75. The value of his estate was \$40,000 which is equivalent to \$546,000 in today's dollars.

Wilkinson Pope & Elizabeth Lewis

Susie Ann's parents, (26) Wilkinson Pope and (27) Elizabeth Lewis were both born in Kentucky as well, in 1833 and 1834. They married in 1853. Wilkinson was a teenager of 17 enumerated with Jones family members in the 1850 Census for the Free Inhabitants of Kentucky. This record is evidence that Wilkinson Pope and his family were free people and had not been slaves.

An obituary notice in the black newspaper, Indianapolis Recorder, said that Wilkinson Pope came to Indianapolis in 1864. He supported wife Elizabeth and his four children as a farm laborer in Indianapolis. In 1870 Census year, only Elizabeth was noted as White. The other family members were noted as Mulatto, an outdated term to describe biracial persons.

Wilkinson labored through the 1880s as a farmer on the farm that he owned. The Popes witnessed their daughter (13) Susie Ann wed (12) Jackson Trabue their neighbor from the adjacent farm. The marriage joined them as family and great-grandparents to (3) Hortense Phyllis Trabue Harris.

Wilkinson and Elizabeth married for 47 years, both in their sixties, still managed the farm in 1900. In 1909, however, (26) Wilkinson Pope passed away at age 75, two years after their daughter Susie Ann. He left behind his wife Elizabeth, after 57 years of marriage, and also valuable real estate. Elizabeth Lewis Pope (27) followed them in



death in 1926. She died at age 92. The Popes and the Trabues are the great²-grandparents to (3) Hortense's children and they were buried in Crown Hill Cemetery in Indianapolis.

Elizabeth Lewis Pope's mother (55) Arthusa B. Stag Lewis, age 37, and Elizabeth's two sisters were enumerated near Louisville in the household of her

Uncle Daniel Stag (Steeg is a typo) in the 1850 Census for the Free Inhabitants of Kentucky. All were enumerated as White, evidence that they also were not slaves. Arthusa was born in 1813 in Kentucky. The first name of (54) Mr. Lewis, her husband, remains unknown, though his birth year was likely similar. He may have died just prior to 1850; that being the reason Arthusa's family was found residing with her brother. The year of Arthusa's death is unknown. Mr. Lewis (54) and Arthusa B. Stag (55) are the great³-grandparents to the children of (3) Hortense Phyllis Trabue Harris.

Where Did the Trabue Surname Come From?



The Trabue surname has always fascinated family members. The research revealed the following. When the Protestants rebelled against the Catholic monopoly of religion in France during the 1500s and 1600s, the Protestants called themselves Huguenots. The Trabue surname is believed to have appeared in the United States when French Protestants came to America

seeking religious freedom. Antoine Trabue was among the first group of Huguenots that arrived in America around 1787. Our Trabue ancestors may be distantly related to this same Frenchman.

THE MANNING LINEAGE

Monroe L. Manning (14) was born in 1868 Kentucky, as was both his parents; and he was also literate. By 1889, age 21, he had moved to Topeka, Kansas, met and married 17-year-old Laura Williams (15). After the loss of three babies, daughter Edna



Beatrice Manning was born in 1893 followed by son Bernice in 1900.

Topeka, Kansas was home for the Manning family until around 1909 when the promise of a better economic life in Chicago pulled (14) Monroe L. Manning and his wife (15) Laura Williams like a magnet across the country. Laura's brother Wayman Williams

and his family accompanied them. A concrete metropolis like Chicago must have seemed a daunting place for 15 year old Edna Beatrice (7), accustomed to having the expansive Kansas sky above her head.

The 1910 Census recorded that Monroe L. Manning rented a home at 3524 Calumet Avenue, a neighbor to other Black families. Monroe, a fireman in Topeka since at least 1900, continued to work as a fireman in Chicago to support his wife, daughter, and son. The occupations of their neighbors on their page of the 1910 Census were maids and janitors, a

dressmaker, hairdresser, postal worker, photographer, and even a physician with his own practice.

Monroe Williams & Harriet Rose

Thirty-two-year-old Laura Williams Manning left her parents (30) Monroe Williams and (31) Harriet Rose in Topeka where she and her husband had lived on the same block a few doors away. Since her Uncle Wayman had traveled to Chicago with her family, teenaged (7) Beatrice, the name she preferred to be called, left behind three

other uncles and three male cousins, as well as Grandpa and Grandma Williams, who she probably never saw again.

Laura's father, Monroe Williams (30), was born in Tennessee in 1842. The 1860 Census for Free Inhabitants of Tennessee enumerated him at age 16 with his parents

(60) Samuel and (61) Ruth Williams as White farm laborers. This is evidence that this Williams family were not slaves.

By 1863, he had traveled to Topeka where he enlisted at age 21 in the famed 1st Kansas Colored Volunteer Infantry of the United States Army, later known as the 79th Regiment. With Company F, he fought in the Civil War at significant Arkansas battle locations. The 79th Regiment became revered for their victories against the Confederates.

When the war ended, Monroe Williams married the daughter of a fellow soldier and friend, William Rose (62). Her name was Harriet Rose (31). According to the 1870 Census, they were enumerated with a four-month-old daughter named Anna, though this child soon drops from the historical records.

Anna's year of death was not found. Monroe and Harriet's next child was (15) Laura Williams, born in 1872.

During the 1870s and 1880s, Monroe Williams supported

his wife and daughter as a teamster delivering goods by horse-

drawn wagon. They continued to increase their family with four sons: Wayman, born 1879, James, born 1882, John, born 1886, and Harrison, the last child discovered on record, born in 1888.

Harriet Rose's mother was Jeanette Rose (63). Jeanette was born in 1805 in Virginia. Although the birthplace of Harriet's father William remains unknown, his birth year is estimated to be around 1805 as well. William and Harriet appear to have lived

the majority of their lives in Topeka and may have already known their future son-in-law before William enlisted about 1863 as a soldier also in the 1st Kansas Colored Volunteer Infantry. He was with Company C of the 79th Regiment.

Following Jeanette Rose (63) through early Topeka City Directories until she no longer appeared suggested that she died about 1877 at age 72.

Shortly after Laura and brother Wayman had settled in Chicago, their father (30) Monroe Williams died in Topeka on 29 November 1909 at age 68. Monroe's Army pension supported their mother Harriet as did their

three younger brothers. Ten months later, on 30 September

1910 according to Civil War pension records, their grandfather William Rose (62) joined Monroe W., his friend and son-in-law, in death at about age 105.

The Manning Family in Chicago

After her father and grandfather's deaths, Laura soon coped with another. Her husband Monroe L. Manning (14) died around 1912 at the age of 43, never to know his grandchildren. The circumstances of his death isn't yet known. He was a fireman and perhaps he died while fighting a fire.

Laura Williams Manning (15), a widow at age 35, persevered and had to support her 19-year-old daughter Beatrice and 12-year-old son Bernice, later nicknamed Uncle Bunk. After meeting Walter Z. Martin, a postal worker, Laura soon married him in January 1914 and became Laura Williams Manning Martin. They began married life in her home on Calumet Avenue.

In Chicago Wayman used his full name, Bishop Wayman Williams, and first found employment as a porter (janitor) for Chicago's elevated rail transit line, but by 1913 he became a Chicago police officer. Beatrice had made friends in her new city accompanied by her mother Laura who enjoyed membership in prestigious socialite circles among

Chicago's Black South Side.

In 1915, at age 22, (7) Beatrice Manning wed a 25-year-old Black pharmacist from

Indianapolis named (6) LeRoy Trabue. They became the parents of six children including (3) Hortense Phyllis Trabue.

In 1924, fifteen years after her father, Laura's mother, Harriet Rose Williams (31), died in Topeka at age 81. Three years later, Laura's brother Wayman was believed to have been shot and killed on duty on 10 August 1927. He was age 48. The details of his death beg for additional research at a later date.

Then in September 1933, Laura Williams Manning Martin (15) died. She was age 56.

Within her being, Hortense Phyllis Trabue Harris carried forth the lineages of her mother's ancestors to her children. Monroe L. Manning (14) and (15) Laura Williams Manning Martin are her children's great-grandparents; Monroe (30) and (31) Harriet Rose Williams are her children's great²-grandparents; Samuel (60) and (61) Ruth Williams and William (62) and (63) Jeanette Rose are her children's great³-grandparents.

THE HARRIS LINEAGE

The 1910 Census enumerated (4) Charles Henry Harris, in Danville, Illinois as a 21-year-old lodger from Ohio. He likely traveled from Cincinnati through Indianapolis and stopped at the first town across the Indiana state line which is Danville. Charles Henry lodged there a short time employed as cook in a restaurant before continuing on to Chicago.

Charles Henry Harris met Bessie Simmons, a single mother of a young son. She was born in Hopkinsville, Kentucky in 1891. Eventually, they married in Chicago a week before Christmas in 1914. Charles Henry and Bessie rented their apartment home at 2317 Prairie Avenue in the Black community of Evanston. Charles Robert (2), Bessie's

second child, was born at home the following September. When Charles Robert Harris (2) entered life in 1916, the United States sought to avoid war on the world stage, the Spanish Influenza epidemic was set to wreak havoc on a global scale, and economic depression waited in the wings and its misery would last a decade. <page-header>

In September 1918, Charles Henry registered for the WW I Draft. He was age 33 and employed as a warehouse laborer. Charles and

Bessie had reached a sad period in their lives because that previous July of 1918 they had buried ten-month-old son Louis, their third child. It isn't known how Louis died, but the flu epidemic was still taking lives at that time.

Charles Henry consistently indicated that his birthplace was Ohio and that knew nothing about where his parents were born. It can be assumed that Charles Henry's relationship with his parents was estranged. Although his mother's name is still unknown, and the year his father arrived in Chicago couldn't be determined, a clue to his father's identity did surface. The genealogy search led to a man named (8) Charles Harris, believed to be Charles Henry's father. Information from (8) Charles Harris' Illinois death record estimates his year of birth as 1861 and it recorded that he died in October 1921 at the age of 60. At the time of death, he lived at 2908 South State Street in Chicago. When he passed, his grandson (2) Charles Robert was age five and may never have had contact with his grandfather or had any memories of him.

Bessie's parents were (10) John Simmons born in 1840 and (11) Catherine Pendleton Sergeant born in 1844. Both her parents had children from previous marriages. Bessie's father worked as a stone mason and her mother worked as a laundress.

In 1930, Charles Henry, Bessie, and their seven children lived at 2348 West Railroad Avenue in the Black segregated conclave of Evanston. Charles worked as a day laborer and Bessie worked for a private family as a laundress. Their oldest son, Frank D., was already a 20-year-old widower with a one-year-old son named Frank E. Both were residing with the family. Son Charles Robert (2), age 14, was noted as a student attending school.

The economic depression of the 1930s was tough on everyone. According to the Evanston City Directory for the year 1935, the Harris family, totaling 10 living children and a grandchild, had moved to 1935 Jackson Avenue. The Directory entry for son (2) Charles Robert indicated that he was in school, likely in his senior year of high school. After graduating, presumed that

same year in 1935, he entered the workforce. Charles Robert worked as a construction laborer and his brother John made deliveries for a grocery store. It is no doubt that their incomes were an essential support of the household. Father Charles Henry (4) was employed at the Pure Oil Company gas station on Green Bay Road in the town of Winnetka as an attendant and car washer since 1935 or before. He was later able to rent a single family home for his growing tribe at 1906 Asbury Avenue.

By 1940 Charles Henry and Bessie had nine remaining years together. They witnessed Charles Robert (2), the first child of their union, court an elegant young woman named (3) Hortense Phyllis Trabue. According to oral family history, Charles

Robert and Hortense liked to attend Chicago's night clubs and to go dancing. Charles Robert and Hortense soon married on October 6, 1940 at Second Baptist Church, likely the Harris family church. It was one of the two oldest black churches in Evanston. The newlyweds began

married life under his parents' roof. That same year, Charles Robert also

began employment at Evanston's Bennison's Bakery.

War was again on the horizon. In 1942 Charles Henry was age 52 when required to register for the World War II Draft. Not long after, Charles Henry and Bessie moved the family to 1914 Asbury. They must have been a comfort to their 26-year-old daughter-in-law Hortense, seven months pregnant with twins, when she buried her mother (7) Edna Beatrice Manning Trabue in February 1945.

1949 had been a year of significant changes for Charles Robert and Hortense. That year charted a new course for their family's future. Having increased the family to five with two sons, a bigger home was needed. In May of 1949, they purchased their first and only home together on 1838 Laurel Avenue. In 1838 Laurel Avenue

November, Hortense was baptized and confirmed in their adopted Catholic faith at St. Andrews Catholic Church. The following month, Charles Henry and Bessie's life together was suddenly

over. On December 30, 1949, Charles Henry Harris (4) passed

at age 60, the same age as his father. Oral family history said that while making repairs underneath a car inside a garage, he succumbed to the car's exhaust fumes. Their address at his death was 1818 Dodge Avenue.

In June of 1950, Charles Robert followed Hortense and received the Catholic rites of baptism and confirmation.

While the Harrises led a busy family life, the inevitability of death again demanded their attention. On June 17, 1954, Hortense buried her father (6) LeRoy Trabue after a long illness. He was age 64. His last address was 1801 Hartrey Avenue, next door to his son Clarence

Trabue at 1811 Hartrey. Then on September 23, 1955, Charles Robert's mother, Bessie Isabel Simmons Harris (5), passed unexpectedly at age 64. According to oral family history, she accidently swallowed and choked on a safety pin she held between her lips.

On Laurel Avenue, five more daughters were born. Charles and Hortense raised

a total of ten children, eight daughters and two sons, while he worked in additional trades as an independent house painter and in maintenance at the Emerson Street YMCA. Charles ran a disciplined household and placed upon his children a strong work ethic. The Harrises defied the norm and sent their children to private Catholic schools.

Hortense supplemented the household income with money earned from her in-home laundry

business. Her clients were the families of local TV personalities, physicians and other business professionals.

After 16 years at the bakery, Charles became employed in 1956 by the new Old Orchard Shopping Center in Skokie maintaining its

grounds and landscaping while Hortense continued to work her laundry business. For

the last 18 years, Charles and Hortense had worked long hours to provide the tuition for the Catholic school education they desired for their children. One by one, their children graduated high school and matured into the upstanding, self-sufficient men and women their parents inspired them to be. Then, on May 4th 1972, after 30 years of marriage, Charles Robert Harris (2) died at age 55.

As the sole provider for her young daughters that remained at home, Hortense

retired her laundry business and became employed by K-mart in 1974. In 1975 she married Ozane Davis, a business owner of a janitorial service. Together, she and Ozane provided for their children and grandchildren. In 1977, they purchased their home at 847 Asbury

in Evanston. It

became the hub of family gatherings on holidays and for celebrations. After 10 years with K-mart, Hortense became employed in 1984 by Marshall Field's

Department Store as a fashion accessories salesperson. As a working mother outside the home, she witnessed all her children graduate high school and enter adulthood. After 19 years of marriage to her husband Ozane Davis, Hortense buried him in September of 1994. He was age 67.

Having been a wife to two husbands, an at-home working mother to 10 children and a laundry business for 36 years, and an employee for an additional 20 years, at age 75 Hortense assessed her life. The warm climate of Atlanta, Georgia appealed to Hortense especially since three of her daughters lived there. She retired from Marshall Field's in 1994 and in 1995 bought a home in suburban Jonesboro for herself and her two dogs. Hortense Phyllis Trabue Harris Davis was content until she passed on December 21, 2000 at the age of 81.

The Harris/Trabue children have lovingly carried forward the memories of both Charles Robert and Hortense Harris to their own children and grandchildren, and within themselves have extended their ancestral lineages from 1797 into the 21st Century.

OUR ANCESTRAL LEGACY

In this present study, the lives of 24 Harris/Trabue ancestors and five generations were reviewed between the years 1797 to 2000. That's over 200 years of history.

Multiple roots grew out of Kansas and Kentucky with one that originated from Tennessee, one from Virginia, as well as one from Ohio. On the paternal side, the Ohio Harris ancestors may have birth histories as free people because Ohio was always a non-slave state. For our Kentucky Simmons ancestors, since they haven't yet been verified in historical records prior to 1880, the question of their free citizenship status before the Civil War remains open. Some of our Trabue ancestors had crossed the racial divide as early as 1850, giving evidence that the Trabue lineage has a history of ancestors who were free people, not slaves.

The Harris/Trabue ancestors were farmers as well as tradesmen in carpentry. They were educated to the extent of primary and secondary education in their day and they insisted that their children be educated as well. They believed in working for what you wanted and that all employment was honorable.


Two related ancestors fought with the 1st Kansas Volunteer Colored Infantry, the valiant 79th Regiment, in the Civil War defending the Union for the freedom of citizenship for their fellow African Americans. Our ancestors aspired to professionalism and excellence in whatever work they did and sought elegance in their social lives and interactions. Homeownership was one of their goals and traditions, and a marker of perseverance and accomplishment. The Harris/Trabue family history is rich and industrious with a solid foundation of faith and self-discipline.

The answer to the questions why we are who we are is this: our Harris/Trabue ancestors, as a result of their deepest struggles and aspirations for themselves and for their children, have passed on to us a kind of spiritual memory. This spiritual memory is inherited at the cellular level. It's in our blood and bones.

If you see any part of yourself in one or more of our ancestors, then this study has accomplished its purpose. Once we know through whom we came to live on earth, we can choose to embrace our ancestors and be uplifted by their accomplishments or seek to change the legacy of circumstances that haven't benefited us.

You probably always assumed you were somebody. After reading this accounting of our ancestors who loved, had faith in a Higher Power, persevered, and scraped out remarkable lives for themselves and their children, you will truly realize that YOU ARE SOMEBODY. Somebody important! You are that future child that our ancestors prayed you'd be given the opportunities to be. Discovering who put the "rungs on the ladder" for us makes our family history valuable to learn and teach to our children.

Gathering information for one's genealogy is never complete. There is always more information to discover about our ancestors and the present generation creates new family history every day. Be encouraged to extend this Harris/Trabue Family History by writing down your own stories of accomplishments and those of each member; then, update the information periodically. Your future grandchildren and greatgrandchildren will thank you.







The Federals repulsed the attacks and finally crossed with all their men and supply wagons, many of which they were compelled to abandon in the swamp north of Saline. The Confederates bungled a good chance to destroy Steele's army, which after crossing the river, regrouped at Little Rock.


